New Service between East Coast of South America, South Africa and Asia.

CSAV is glad to inform a new service between the East Coast of South America, South Africa and Asia.

This new service allows us to offer our valuable customers a better frequency and an increased coverage on the mentioned trade lanes.

The new set up consists of two slings with weekly fixed rotation which we detail as follows:

Sling 1: 11 x 6500 teu vessels, 6 of them operated by CSAV:

Pusan - Shanghai - Ningbo - Chiwan - Hong Kong - Port Kelang - Rio de Janeiro - Santos - Montevideo Buenos Aires - Rio Grande - Paranagua - Santos - Durban - Port Kelang - Hong Kong - Pusan.

Sling 2: 10 x 4200 teu vessels 4 of them operated by CSAV:

Shanghai - Ningbo - Xiamen - Kaohsiung - Hong Kong - Shekou - Port Kelang - Santos - Paranagua - Itajai - Santos - Rio de Janeiro - Nqura - Singapore Hong Kong - Shanghai.

We want to highlight some additional features this new service offers our customers :

- New Chinese ports: Xiamen and Shekou.
- Two weekly calls at South Africa: Durban and Nqura.
- New markets: Pusan (Korea), Kaohsiung (Taiwan) and Port Kelang (Malaysia).
- Two calls per week in Asia at Shanghai, Ningbo, Hong-Kong and Port Kelang.
- Two calls per week in ECSA at Rio de Janeiro, Santos and Paranagua.
- Weekly service from/to Itajai.
- Weekly service from/to Buenos Aires and Montevideo.
- Weekly call at Singapore.

This new service will be jointly operated with CMA CGM and China Shipping.

This new service is a demonstration of CSAV's commitment towards our customers and we are confident it will fulfill all their expectations.
